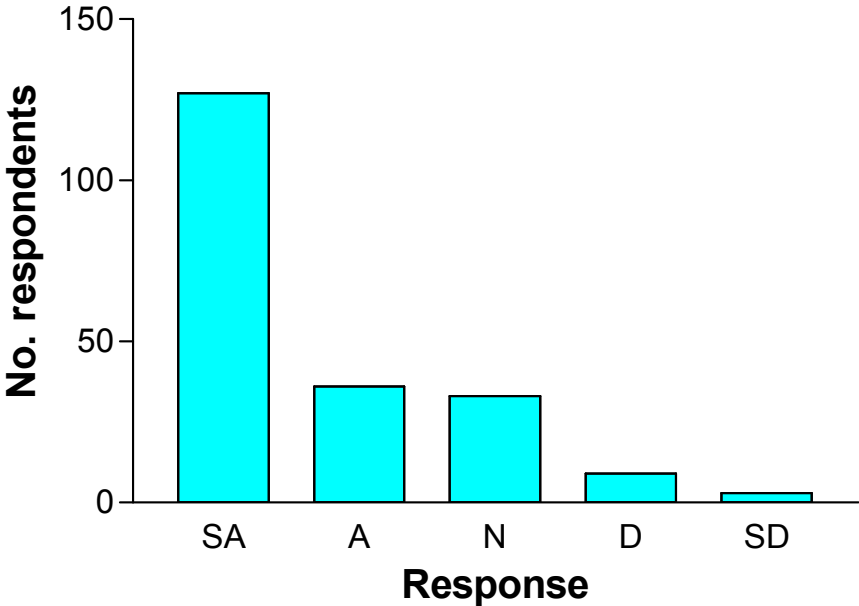
No bottle store should be allowed in Cape St Francis
